

Why a new organ?

The current organ is old, with faulty wiring, many non-functional features, incompatible old technology, and vast musical limitations.

A new organ would enhance our services and events, giving us greater opportunity to serve God and our neighbors.

How much would a new organ cost?

Like anything else, there are many tiers of cost for organs. Our desired instrument costs about \$100,000.

Does this include installation?

Yes, this includes every aspect of organ and sound

installation.

What kind of organ would it be? Would it still have pipes?

We are looking at a Rodgers 351. This organ can function beautifully as solely electric or as a hybrid with pipes. The sounds are samples from the very best organs from around the world and has limitless capability for concert repertoire as well as service music in many styles. This is the organ brand that has been used at Carnegie Hall for decades. See the full brochure *here*.

How much money do we need to achieve this goal?

We have approximately \$50,000 from a generous donor, so we're about halfway there!
